DIRECTIONS TO RACE



FROM THE NORTH

Take Interstate 5 south to the Pacific Coast Highway/Camino Las Ramblas exit (approximately 15 miles south of the 405 and 5 Interchange). As soon as you exit you will come to a fork; bear right. You are now on Pacific Coast Highway (northbound). Drive 1 mile and turn left onto Dana Point Harbor Drive.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take Interstate 5 north to the Beach Cities/Camino Las Ramblas off-ramp. Once you leave the freeway get into the left lane. After you pass through the tunnel you will be on Pacific Coast Highway. Continue about 3/4 mile to the second traffic light which is Dana Point Harbor Drive. Turn left onto Dana Point Harbor Drive.

PADDLERS

Turn left at Doheny State Park entrance which is the first traffic light. A shuttle from the State Park to the boat launch area will be provided. State Park charges \$15.00 parking per vehicle.

ESCORT BOATS & CANOES

Turn left at Embarcadero Place and at gate follow instructions where to park.

COACHES PLEASE READ IN DETAIL

BOAT LAUNCH: Gate fee is \$18 per canoe. We strongly recommend that all Club's and escort boat operators arrange to bring their boats down on Friday before the race. Overnight parking is an additional \$18 per canoe. This is a public launch ramp so it could be full by 6:30 a.m. on Saturday. The Dana Outrigger Canoe Club does not accept responsibility for canoes and/or escort boats that are unable to gain entry due to a full launch ramp. There is no other launch ramp in the area should you arrive late and be turned away. We also recommend you bring cradles to rest and rig your canoe on since this area is completely paved. All trailers must be removed Saturday night.

REGISTRATION: All registration will take place in the morning prior to the women's race. Registration will close at 8:00 A.M. If you only have a men's team racing you still must register in the morning.

ESCORT BOATS: Any Club bringing their own escort boats are required to check with their driver for proof of insurance. If you need an escort boat, the fee is \$400 per boat. Check must be made out to Dana Outrigger, not the escort boat captain. Be sure to bring enough checks to cover registration and escort boat fees. Escort boat fees will be refunded only if you cancel by Saturday, August 3rd. Any cancelation after the 3rd will result in the club paying the full day for the driver. PLEASE NOTE: If you request 3 boats and only need 2 on race day, you will be required to pay for 3 boats in order to be assigned your 2 boats.

It is the coach's responsibility to contact the escort boat operator to prearrange a meeting place and to exchange pertinent information (canoe colors, name, etc.). If you bring your own escort boat, DOCC will have an information package available for your driver. Please respect your escort boat owners requests at all times and always let common courtesy prevail. Offer to help clean and rinse vessels. Should your boat owner place a complaint, your escort boat privilege will be denied the following year. If you supply your own escort boat you still must turn in the boat operator's waiver at the time of registration.

RACE COURSE: The course will run from Dana Point to Main Beach Laguna Beach. There will only be one steerspersons meeting. This will be held at 8:00 a.m. just prior to the start of the women's race. If your men's steersmen is not available at that time, then coaches are responsible to relay the race course information to them.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Doheny State Park is an alcohol free park. No alcoholic beverages are to be sold or consumed in the park. Violators will be cited. We would appreciate that everyone observe this park mandate.
